This information has been compiled and converted into electronic media to eliminate the need for cumbersome volumes of printed material. Every effort has been made to make navigation through this program as easy as possible. Generac assumes that the user has a certain amount of basic computer literacy. Please make an effort to become familiar with the use of the software provided on this disc. The online help guides provided by the author of the software are invaluable reference tools, and should be consulted when questions arise.

Here are a few simple tips:

- Each manual or document on this disc is linked to a menu. Each menu is linked to several manuals or documents.
- The link to each manual or document is provided in the form of an orange button. Clicking on the orange button once will open the specified document.
- When open, the document can be navigated by clicking on the bookmarks visible in the left hand portion of the computer screen. Additionally, any Tables of Contents within the document have been linked to the specified topics. These links are activated by moving the mouse over the text until the open hand (cursor) becomes a pointing finger, then clicking on the text. There are other ways to navigate through a document, such as using the page up and down keys, the arrow keys, or the tools located on the toolbar at the top of the computer screen. The visible area can also be magnified to make text more readable. This is also achieved by using the toolbar icons (magnifying glass, page icons, etc.). Consult the online help guide for instructions in the use of these tools.
- Returning to the menu portion of the disc is achieved by clicking on the bookmark named "Menu" found in the left hand portion of the viewing screen.
- There are a few sub-menus, each opened by a clearly labeled orange button.
- The program can be closed by clicking on the "EXIT" button found on each sub-menu.
